

2-YEAR GRANT UPDATE



Report from the Membership at Large Meeting held on March 6, 2024: Grants Chairwoman, Laura Bryant addressed the members with an update regarding the status of the former 2-Year Grant recipient, the **Dream Queens Foundation**, which had dissolved and is now **Life Atlas**.



The dissolution and change in the organization's structure ended SMWL Foundation's two year grant commitment, as it is not the same organization the Membership voted for, and their philosophies and projects had also changed. TREASURER'S REPORTS

LEAGUE: The Board reviewed the Financial Report with Statements and Reconciliation for January and February 2024. At the end of February 2024, the balance was \$5,463.41. Treasurer, Pam Frank reported that dues are all up-to-date.

FOUNDATION: The Board reviewed the Financial Report with Statements and Reconciliation for January and February 2024. At the end of February 2024, the balance in the Foundation Account was \$15,494.33.

The balance in the CD was \$34,399.97 and the Chesapeake Charities Endowed Fund had \$49,879.00 on the last report received.

Renewal of the 14-Month Certificate of Deposit for SMWL Foundation: Maturity: 4/19/2024: Foundation Treasurer, Ruth Mudd shared the CD in WesBanco would have another 14 months term at 4.25%.

The Board agreed that the Foundation monies should continue to earn as much interest as possible until the funds are needed for donations.

FOUNDATION NEWS CONTINUED...

After discussion and answers to questions, the Membership at Large voted to move forward with **The Poeima Movement** as the new incoming grant recipient. And further, membership wanted to give the grant recipient the full two years of support, and agreed the Grant Selection process should be delayed a year until October 2026 going into January 2027.

Laura notified Tiffany Barber, the administrator for Poeima. She and her staff are ecstatic to be partnering with SMWL and would like to be active in any role regarding fundraising and upcoming SMWL events. Tiffany also plans to put together an event/meeting in the near future where members could learn more about their process and the movement. Dinner would be provided by Tiffany and her staff on a Thursday evening. More information and dates are to follow.

Tiffany is preparing a new grant application for the SMWL Foundation Grant Committee to review to understand their upcoming needs and ways that SMWL could support them. Laura's report pointed out that Federal and State funds had been awarded to Poeima with a \$600,000 grant to build a new facility that will house mothers and their children. This will be a great opportunity for SMWL as an organization to help and assist with this project.

NEW BUSINESS: In response to a question asked during our General Membership (March 6th) meeting in regards to the partnership with the College of Southern Maryland and our annual scholarship commitment, the Board discussed the history and intent of this partnership and the original Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), its benefits to the community and the League and our Foundation. It was unanimously agreed by the BOD to continue with the MOU/ partnership with the College of Southern Maryland Foundation as SMWL does see the impact the scholarships have made in several of the recipient's lives and through our community support, and League sponsorship recognition at all SMWL/CSM supported events.

The BOD also agreed, to encourage interested members to volunteer to be part of a *Scholarship Initiative Committee* to explore scholarships for Southern Maryland students who may plan to attend other institutions of higher learning. **Pam Frank** agreed to Chair the Committee, and **Tequila House** to serve as well.
