Bi-Annual Grant Recipient:

On May 11th the membership received presentations from Dream Queens, Poeima Movement and the Catherine Foundation. Grants Chairperson, Laura Forbes, informed those present that we had a tough decision to make and she was certainly correct. We heard from three remarkable groups, and the membership voted to select *The Dream Queen Foundation* as the SMWL Bi-Annual Grant recipient.

The Dream Queen Foundation will receive a total up to \$15,000 over two years, which makes it possible for the group to establish two new clubs in Charles County. The Poeima Movement, and the Catherine Foundation will each receive a \$500 donation. Thank you Laura for a job well done!

Also, SMWL is open to receiving Small Grant Applications any time throughout the year. The Small Grant Application is available on our website: www.smwl.org/small-grants. Please encourage groups to apply.

Applications should be sent to Laura for her Committee to review and forwarded to the Board for final approval. The Board can approve up to \$1,000 without membership approval. Amounts in excess of \$1,000 are presented to the membership for approval.

Finally, in order to provide the programming that members have indicated they want and expect, the annual dues will be increased.

Membership Dues:

In order to fully fund the club's administrative costs and off-set program costs, the Board set the Annual Membership Dues for the upcoming fiscal year (2022/2023) Board at \$250.00.

This amount will be invoiced on **June 1st and due** in **full by July 1st, 2022**. If you have special circumstances that require a payment plan, please notify the Corporation Treasurer, Pam Frank. Any member requesting a payment plan must pay in full by September 1, 2022. Unless a member has an approved payment plan, failure to pay dues by July 1 will result in loss of membership privileges, or if an approved payment plan is not paid in full by September 1, membership privileges will be lost.

I apologize in advance if this sounds harsh but we must collect dues such that we have funds on hand to pay bills. Special thanks to Pam Frank for handling all of the invoices and payments. This is considerable work and it is appreciated.

Fundraiser & Foundation:

The membership was very clear that it wants to retain and maintain the SMWL Foundation. Members indicated that they want to work collectively to raise funds to meet the important needs of women (and children). However, everyone prefers that we NOT host a fundraiser this fiscal year (7/1/2022 - 6/30/23).

The SMWL Bylaws require every member to participate in a fundraiser and authorizes the Board to establish a monetary contribution in lieu of participation in a fundraiser. Upon the recommendation of the Ad Hoc Committee on Fundraising, the Board approved a **\$250 monetary contribution** to be made by every member to the Foundation, in lieu of participating in a fundraiser in this fiscal year. The club will resume fundraising in the 2023/2024 fiscal year.



Don't take your friend for granted, thinking they won't be gone.


